

PRESS RELEASE

The CDI of Compiegne began Thursday, May 19, 2016, with the Grand Prix of the CDI 3*, as well as the test Saint-Georges of the CDI 2*.

Carl HESTER (GBR) begins this weekend by a great performance winning the Grand Prix of the CDI 3* - Prix Barriquand, associated with Nip Tuck (74.160%) and by being classified third with Wanadoo (72.020%). In the second place there is Patrick KITTEL (SWE), on Delaunay (72.780%). Adelinde CORNELISSEN (NED), which carried out its first Grand Prix 3* with Aqiedo, does a beautiful performance being classified fourth, with a

Carl Hester (GBR) et Nip Tuck – GP CDI 3* note of 71,880%.



Concerning the CDI 2*, Germany had the place of honor with the victory of Kathleen KELLER (GER) who wins the test Saint-Georges – Prix Lanson, with Desperados 29 and the note of 73,237%. The podium is completed by two Belgian riders: Sophie VAN LENT – BAETENS (BEAUTIFUL) on Captain Jack (71.132%) in the second place and Liselot DUPONT (BEAUTIFUL) and Expression, in the third place with a note of 70,526%.

On the program, Friday, May 20th, 2016, the continuation of the CDI 3* and 2* with Intermediate the 1 CDI 2* - Prix ARC and the Special Grand Prix CDI 3* - Prix Brézillon, on the principal arena. Place also to the young riders of Dressage with the categories CDI Under 25, Young Rider, Junior and Pony, for their first day of competition in the CDI of Compiegne.

The CDIO 5* will begin Saturday, May 21st with the Grand Prix – Prix of the Town of Compiegne.
