

Sunday 21, May, 2017

This last day took place under a beautiful sun and the great public came to admire the performances of these exceptional riders.

As for the CDIO 5* - FEI Nations Cup, this stage is won by the team from Great Britain with a score of 440,996. The team was composed of Gareth Hughes, Daniel Watson, Spencer Wilton and Hayley Watson-Greaves. Sweden ranks second with a score of 432,958. The Netherlands completed the podium in third place (430.136).

The chef d'équipe of Great-Britain, Caroline Griffith, commented: "My riders perform brilliantly in spite of the several good riders. I am very happy because all the scores could have counted for the final score, they were amazing. Compiègne is a very good competition for both horses and riders, and the arenas were very nice to ride for the riders."

The Freestyle of the CDIO 5* - FEI Nations Cup, Prix Crédit Mutuel Nord Europe, was a great show for the public of Compiègne.

The event was won by Helen Langehanenberg (ALL) and Damsey RH, with a score of 79.575%. In second place, with very little difference, the Swedish Patrik Kittel and Deja get a score of 79.325%. Finally, in the third place, the British Hayley Watson-Greaves, signs a good performance with Rubins Nite and a note of 75.325%. Some words from the winner, Helen Langehanenberg : "Compiègne is a very good competition, the reception is nice and the tracks are very good. It was a good weekend and I will be back next year. "

The Grand Prix Special of the CDIO 5* - FEI Nations Cup - Prix Mauboussin, ended with the victory of Spencer Wilton (GBR), who already won the Grand Prix of the day before, with Super Nova II and a very good score. 78,353%.

Anders Dahl is second in this class, with Selten HW (73.176%) and Adelinde Cornelissen third with Aqiedo (72.882%).

International Dressage of Compiègne May, 18 to 21, 2017

The Youths completed their competition with the Freestyle classes.

The first to start were riders U25. Three riders from the Netherlands are on the podium and the victory goes to Jeanine Nieuwenhuis and TC Athene (75.375%) in this Prix SITA SUEZ.

Great-Britain won in the Freestyle of the CDI Ponies. This freestyle was won by Anya Kolleth Equestrian and SL Lucci (73.325%).

In the CDI Junior the victory of the Freestyle was for Suraya Hendriks and Dear Friend 2 (74.700%), for Belgium.

The last prize of the day was marked by the victory of Lianne Zoutendijk and Kostendrukkers Ringo Star (75.100%), in the CDI Young Riders.

For the first time a CDI Young Horses was on the program of these Dressage International of Compiègne. The opportunity to discover the talents of tomorrow.

The finals of these classes saw the victory of:

- Patrick van der Meer and President's First Apple (81.472%), in the CDI YH 7yo
- Jeanine Nieuwenhuis and Great Lady TC (88.4%) in the CDI YH 6yo
- Mara de Vries and Habibi DVB (86.8%).
